When the prophet Samuel came to anoint Israel's next king, David wasn't even considered by his own father. Yet God said, "The Lord does not look at the things people look at... the Lord looks at the heart" (1 Samuel 16:7).

Living in the Rhythm of the Seasons!


We dwell within the sacred cycle of the four seasons, each whispering its truth. But of them all, Spring forever holds my heart.

Testimony

FAITH, FAMILY, AND A SECOND CHANCE: OUR MIRACLE IN INDIA

Testimon of Br Br. Nevin & Sis Jincy.

The moment the air seemed to still, panic set in. Gianna lay in her bed, her tiny body seized in a terrifying convulsion. I rushed to her side, my heart pounding as I called out her name. It was a scene that would forever be etched in my mind. We raced her to Believers Church Medical College, where time seemed to stretch as doctors fought to stabilize her condition. In those moments, our world felt on the brink of collapse.

Yet, amid this medical chaos, we clung to hope and faith. Days before this alarming episode, I was preparing for what I thought would be the pivotal moment of my life: reuniting with my family in Perth after being apart for four months. I had imagined that the difficult journey of finding a job, a house, and a car in a new city was behind me. But on the eve of departing for India to bring them to their new home, this unexpected crisis with Gianna made me realize the real test of faith and perseverance was beginning.

During those long, sleepless nights, I found comfort in a Bible verse: "If the foundations are destroyed, what can the righteous do?" (Psalm 11:3). Yet, I questioned God at times. Why was this happening to Gianna? Had we not been faithful? Each update from the doctors felt heavy and was always labeled as 'critical.' Amid the doubt, we found strength in the love, prayers, and support from friends, family, and our church. Their hope surrounded Gianna's recovery.

One afternoon, worry filled the air as we sat outside the ICU. Seeing Jacob's determination to pray inspired me to promise I would fast until Gianna came home. I called Jincy, my voice shaking, and together we prayed intensely, trusting the Holy Spirit to guide us. The support from our church community gave us hope and helped us stay strong.

That night, we learned Gianna had a high fever and needed an MRI the next day. Amid this stress, a supportive pastor and family prayed with us at the hospital.



Gianna's sudden medical crisis shattered our plans and tested our faith. Amid fear and uncertainty, we leaned on prayer, Scripture, and the unwavering support of our church community. Through sleepless nights and critical updates, hope endured. Love, fasting, and spiritual unity became our anchor until healing began to unfold.



Amid medical uncertainty and prayerful perseverance, Gianna's recovery unfolded miraculously. From ICU struggles to a joyful cry for ice cream, God's presence and the message "Talitha Kumi" carried us through with hope, faith, and awe.

A significant turning point came after the MRI, when we heard the fantastic news that everything was normal. Overwhelmed with gratitude, I went up to the sixth floor, which was under construction, and found a quiet place to pray. There, we prayed together, and I felt the Holy Spirit encouraging me to pray in tongues. It was a decisive moment in our journey of faith.

After two long days, we finally saw a bit of hope. The constant hum of the ventilator and the antiseptic smell of the ICU were ever-present, but Gianna's condition had stabilized, and her fever had gone down. The doctors planned to take her off the ventilator, but when they did, she went into shock. They explained that her first intubation had damaged her trachea, so we had to consider a tracheostomy, which could have long-term effects.

Because of this, the doctors kindly decided to try taking out the tube again. In that uncertain moment, I felt the Holy Spirit say, "One day is enough for my God to work." This gave me new hope.

I left the doctor's room and joined our loved ones for prayer. It was heartwarming to know that our pastors and friends were surrounding us with love. Pastor Litty shared the message, "Talitha Kumi, little girl, arise." That evening, a prophet visited us and also received the message: "Talitha Kumi," reinforcing our belief that God would guide Gianna.

The next morning, doctors discussed the precaution of a tracheostomy. Feeling God's presence, I held Gianna's hand and prayed boldly, "Talitha Kumi, little girl Gianna, arise." With hope in my heart, I continued to lift my prayers.

About half an hour later, we were called back to the ICU, and the doctors met us with relief. "The wonderful news is that Gianna is breathing normally!" they said. We were so happy, but then we learned that Gianna didn't recognize anyone, not even us. She couldn't speak, and the gravity of the situation hit us when the doctor stated with a somber tone, "It might take a month for her to regain her speech and memory." In that moment, my heart sank, but we knew our journey was just beginning, so we continued to hope.

As we got ready to leave, I felt desperate and prayed again. Suddenly, I felt a quiet reminder to trust that the doctor's words weren't the final answer. That night, we received a call to return to the ICU. To our surprise, Gianna was sitting up and asking for chocolate ice cream! When she saw us, her face lit up, and she called out, "Mummy!" We were overjoyed and thanked God for this miracle, amazed that she improved in just hours instead of a month.

Gianna immediately recognized my wife, but she wasn't sure about me or my parents. She had gotten MRSA during the intubation. Even so, I kept praying, trusting that God would help us through.

The next morning, I visited Gianna and was relieved to see her calm, especially with Jincy. The nurse asked who I was, and Gianna's face lit up as she said, "This is Daddy!" She still didn't recognize my parents or ask about Rayanna, though. I talked to the doctor, who reassured me that the MRSA was being treated well.

The doctor said we could go home the next day, even though Gianna hadn't fully regained her memory. When we moved from the ICU to a regular room, she recognized our parents right away. She was so excited on the drive home, and I thanked God.

Even after we left the hospital, Gianna's legs were still weak and shaky. We went to CMC Vellore for a second opinion. When Jincy's mother saw children laughing on sports day, she cried, breaking my heart. Her tears mirrored every parent's fear—the longing for their child's well-being, the hope that their child would one day run with the same carefree joy. That night, I prayed with all my heart for Gianna to walk again, trusting in Jesus' name.



The next day was the turning point. Gianna started walking and soon ran and climbed the stairs joyfully. We went home, celebrating what God had done. We're so grateful for the prayers and support from our church and people worldwide. God is truly great and worthy of praise!

In reflecting on this journey, I've learned that in our darkest moments, when we choose to hold onto faith and love, we uncover a strength we never knew we had. Even when the path is uncertain, embrace hope and trust in the power of community and divine grace to guide you.
